ITV today confirms the new Head of News for ITV West Country will be Nimesh Joshi, who is currently Programme and Digital Editor at ITV Central.

It's an incredible and varied patch, which is really exciting - especially in the year of the General Election and with all the great work I've seen on the West Country regional rail on ITVX.
