Timothy Spall OBE to star in Magpie Murders adaptation which begins production next week

[March 5, 2021] Eleventh Hour Films, MASTERPIECE and BritBox UK today announced that BAFTA-nominated actor Timothy Spall OBE (Mr Turner, Summer of Rockets) has been cast alongside Lesley Manville CBE (Phantom Thread, Let Him Go, Mum) in the upcoming adaptation of Anthony Horowitz's acclaimed and best-selling crime novel Magpie Murders which begins production next week.

Helmed by director Peter Cattaneo (The Full Monty, Military Wives, The A Word), Magpie Murders will shoot in Suffolk and Ireland, and will launch on BritBox UK and MASTERPIECE on PBS in 2022.
