The high-flying member of Harold Wilson's Government, vanished from the beach of a large luxury hotel in Florida in November 1974, leaving a neatly folded pile of clothes as he swam into the sea, intent on faking his own death.

John Boyega has curated a collection of his favourite films for the service, ahead of movies including Pacific Rim Uprising joining the streamer in coming months.
