




In With a Shout Saturday, 7pm 15th April ITV1






Manhunt: The Raoul Moat Story Wednesday, 9pm 19th April ITV1




Paul O'Grady For the Love of Dogs Thursday, 8.30pm 20th April ITV1




Redemption Friday, 9pm 21st April ITV1




Hell's Kitchen Tuesday & Wednesday, 9pm 18th & 19th April ITV2




Goodwood Members' Meeting Live Saturday, 2pm 15th April ITV4
