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

Inspired by the real Joan Hannington and certain events from her life, this exhilarating and emotional new six-part series is created and written by the acclaimed screenwriter Anna Symon (The Essex Serpent, Mrs Wilson) and directed by BAFTA winner Richard Laxton (Rain Dogs, The Thief, His Wife and the Canoe, Mrs Wilson).

The series opens with Joan, a fiery and uncompromising woman in her twenties who is deeply scarred and vulnerable - she is a devoted mother to her six-year-old daughter Kelly but is trapped in a disastrous marriage with a violent criminal named Gary. When Gary goes on the run, Joan seizes the opportunity to create a new life for herself and her daughter.

Adopting new identities and making new acquaintances along the way, Joan becomes a masterful jewel thief - she embarks on a thrilling and high-stakes journey that challenges her every limit while driven by her desire to care for her daughter and create a secure home for them both.

Sophie Turner stars alongside Frank Dillane (Renegade Nell, Fear the Walking Dead, Harry Potter and the Half Blood Prince) as Boisie, a London antique dealer. Kirsty J. Curtis (Rise of the Footsoldier, Match Not Found, Harlots) plays Nancy, Joan's older sister and a salon worker, while Gershwyn Eustache Junior (A Spy Among Friends, I May Destroy You, Top Boy) portrays Albie, an old acquaintance of Boisie who has made a new life in Spain with his wife Val played by Laura Aikman (Archie, Gavin & Stacey, Breeders).

Other actors joining the series include Nick Blood (Agents of S.H.I.E.L.D, Safe), Jack Greenlees (Strike, Harlots), Alex Blake (The Crown, Chernobyl), Caroline Faber (Grantchester, Berlin Station) and Dorothy Atkinson (The Gold, Stonehouse).

# Until I Kill You



The extraordinary true story of Delia Balmer, who survived a near-fatal relationship with murderer John Sweeney, is the subject of this drama.

BAFTA-winning actress Anna Maxwell Martin (Motherland, A Spy Among Friends) will take the role of Delia Balmer while renowned actor and director Shaun Evans (Endeavour, Vigil) will play John Sweeney.

Based on Delia Balmer's book Living with a Serial Killer, Until I Kill You was written by Nick Stevens (The Pembrokeshire Murders).

In 1991, Delia leads an itinerant and solitary life in London working as an agency nurse - when she meets fellow free spirit John Sweeney in a local pub, it seems like the connection she has been searching for.

As the relationship develops, Sweeney's artistic anti-establishment persona gives way to a darker side culminating in a series of violent attacks on Delia, during which he tells her that he killed his former girlfriend and disposed of her body in an Amsterdam canal.

Sweeney is arrested, but he is granted bail due to a catastrophic failure by the court to realise how dangerous he is. He immediately pursues Delia and subjects her to a horrific near-fatal attack - she survives, but Sweeney evades capture and disappears.

Shattered by the trauma and injuries inflicted by Sweeney, Delia bravely seeks to rebuild her life, but Sweeney returns seven years later and is arrested for the murder of another girlfriend in North London. Delia's fragile recovery is shattered all over again as she has to face Sweeney in open court, her testimony vital to the prosecution case against him.

This is the story of one woman's astonishing will to survive through physical and emotional torment despite the failings of the institutions which were meant to protect her.

Until I Kill You narrates the ordeal that Delia suffered at the hands of John Sweeney and her traumatic journey through the police and criminal justice system as they attempt to prosecute him for his crimes.



# The Long Lost Family team takes on searches on behalf of people who believe they or their family may have been taken in Spain.

Thousands of people come to Long Lost Family looking for missing family every year, but something unusual happened last year. First, Ruth Appleby got in touch - she had given birth to her first child, a daughter, in Spain in 1992. She said: 'I believed for 19 years that my daughter had died. And then, suspicions came to light that my daughter may not have died and was stolen at birth...' Another searcher then got in touch telling a similar story.

Maria Elena, a Spanish woman living in London, approached Long Lost Family on behalf of her 93-year-old mother Ana - she said that she and Ana believe that Ana's twin babies, a boy and a girl born in Madrid in 1958, may have been stolen at birth.

Ruth, Maria Elena and Ana believe their cases are part of a scandal in Spain where a huge number of women have come forward since 2011 who believe that their babies were taken from them at birth and given – or sold – to other families.

As well as the move from single hours to short-form series, Fresh Cuts 3.0 welcomed aspiring directors to apply with or without an idea of their own, to produce content for this year's strand. Making their directorial debut for ITV, the selected producer-directors for Black History Month 2024 are Moses Ssebandeke with his profile series Alter Egos, Sammy Ofori-Attah's Black Magic with Trixy, and Destiny Williams' light-hearted Dogs of Grime.

For Disability History Month 2024, programming includes Stephanie Symington's makeover series Date My Nan, Richard Walker's Disabled talent-led chat show Unfiltered Women, and Molly Dennis' cooking show Takeaway or Fakeaway.

Natalie Rose has been appointed as the Executive Producer, overseeing the strand for MultiStory Media, and Commissioning Editor Richard Botchway will oversee the series for Sue Murphy's Fact Entertainment team.

Fresh Cuts is funded through ITV's £80 million Diversity Commissioning Fund which launched in 2022 - over the past two years, Fresh Cuts has provided opportunities to eight directors earning a BAFTA nomination along the way. Among them is Jason Osborne, whose first network documentary commission for ITV was nominated in the Emerging Talent: Factual category.

In conjunction with Black History Month and Disability History Month, as part of ITV's commitment to support and commission content from diverse-led businesses, Amplify: the Companies was launched. As part of this initiative, two companies have been selected to produce a short-form series, one from a Disabled-led company and another from a company led by People of Colour. These series will be released during the respective commemorative months.

Postcard Productions will produce Ash Holme - What Not To Do with Dad, following the presenter and content creator as she takes in different experiences with her dad, and Gold Wala will produce Evil Escapes following three disabled comedians, including 'Lost Voice Guy' Lee Ridley, as they take a spooky road trip across the UK and attempt to prank and out-scare each other while exploring Britain's scariest and weirdest attractions.

# **Nations League**



# ITV will show six of England's Nations League ties live and exclusively this autumn as part of its new deal with UEFA to become home of the Three Lions from September 2024.

Starting with the Republic of Ireland away at the Aviva Stadium in Dublin, England will play Finland and Greece at home, then Finland away before travelling to Greece and rounding off the run with a home game against the Republic of Ireland.

The new deal means that all European qualifiers, UEFA Nations League ties and friendlies between major tournaments will be shown live, exclusive and free-to-air on ITV through to June 2028.

Featured will be England's bid to reach the 2026 FIFA World Cup finals in North America followed by the European qualifiers to UEFA EURO 2028 - all matches home and away for both campaigns will be shown across ITV. In addition, all England matches in the UEFA Nations League and all England friendlies will be shown by ITV.

In total, at least 40 matches - approximately ten each season - will be shown by ITV over the period the rights deal covers.
