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SERIES SYNOPSIS

Weekender is back and this season our reps are in the Greek party capital, Kavos, to give their guests a weekend to remember! Head rep David Potts, aka 'El Jefe', returns and he's brought with him, his most experienced rep, Tash. David has made her his Deputy, which is just as well, as he has a new team of rookies to train up, 'David style'.

New reps, Lucy, Jaegia, Ethan and Joel arrive with bags of energy but it's not long before they start focusing more on *each other* than the job.

With a new hotel, a new location, a new team of reps and a new mantra (*The Pursuit Of Excellence, anyone?*) has David bitten off more than he can chew? Or will he need to bring in some reinforcements? Expect a heady mix, packed with parties down at the legendary Kavos strip, sizzling summer romances, jaw dropping surprises and the return of one *very* familiar face.

Can you introduce yourself?

I'm David, I'm the head rep on the show – I have been for years. Obviously. No one else is going to be able to do it like I do it. I'm fun, outgoing, a bit sassy... I'm ready for a good party.

Why do you love being a rep?

It's just right up my street. Especially the fact I'm head rep, because I get to boss them about a bit, which I kind of love... The going out, the partying, the meeting new people, the entertaining (because I'm not shy of putting on a little bit of a performance for guests). It's just a bit of me.

What's your management style as head rep?

Fun, but firm. I let them know they've got to listen but I bring a fun edge to it. I'm not a boring boss. A bit sassy, sarcastic and realistic. It can be a bit complicated if I'm really close to them. I could be laughing, but I know I need to be serious.

What makes a good rep?

Someone who is out going, definitely, you've got to be up for a laugh! Not necessarily to embarrass yourself, but not bothered about making fun of yourself, being silly, being daft.

How was your summer in Kavos?

It was absolutely BOILING! Let's just start with that. It was unreal to go somewhere new. It was going to be a new experience, a new destination so different clubs, different activities. Different food. The Greek food was good. I love a bit of feta, me.

This time around, things didn't go to plan for me... but you'll have to watch and find out. I hate to be the centre of attention...but here I am.

Memorable moments?

So many amazing nights out. The activities. But I think it was being back with Tash, for me. Me and Tash are really good friends. We met on the strip, we were walking down the strip, we were vibing! We got to the hotel, we were dancing, we popped open a bottle of prosecco! We were jumping in the pool. It was fun doing it with Tash again.

As head rep, how do you keep your sparkle every day?

For me it comes quite naturally. I'm a very positive person and I'm always ready to rumble. I have to project that on to the other reps. It is tiring! Maybe there's been a bit of drama, so I

get a bit of David dust and sprinkle it on them! At the end of the day, we are here to do a job. You've got to be on it!

Did your team find romances?

There was romance. More than one. But did it go to plan? Did it not? You'll have to wait and find out! I've never had a romance while repping, but I've seen ALOT of them! It can sometimes be a recipe for disaster. We're getting stunning guests, we're in a hot destination, people are drinking, people get hot under the collar. It can get a bit dramatic sometimes but who doesn't love the drama? Because I do.

Why should viewers watch Kavos Weekender?

It's one of those shows that everyone loves to watch because it's fun, it lifts people's mood, it's not volatile. It's young people, going out partying. The drama! It just gets everyone in a good mood. I get so many messages asking for it to come back! Expect the expected.

Can you say something in Greek?

Erm. (David pauses, his hands in head, and consults his phone). To afentikó. The Boss.

Can you introduce yourself?

My name is Jordan, if you've watched the Weekender brand for many a year, you'll obviously recognise my face. I'm the 'OG' cast member of the show, I've been on it since Magaluf day one – and you'll see me pop up in our brand-new location this series.

What's so special about the Weekender brand that makes you return?

It's a show that's like no other. The thing that I think is amazing is it shows the rawness, the realness, because we film 24 hours a day. Anyone can go on the show, no matter where you are from, we welcome everyone. We try and give everyone an amazing time, as much as we make mistakes along the way – let's be honest, as reps - we do make a lot – we try and make sure everyone has an amazing time abroad.

What lessons have you learnt over the years on Weekender?

There were new boys on this series and they reminded myself of the old me, when I first started being a rep. I didn't want the boys making the same mistakes I did, I could guide them in the right path so they don't get sacked! I've been sacked and I don't want any of them going through that!

You've shaped a career out of repping, partying, and DJing...

When I started on Weekender, I didn't know what the show would become, and it grew and grew. It's completely changed my life. I believe everything happens for a reason. It's a show that I'm so grateful to still be part of. I wouldn't be where I am today if it wasn't for the show.

Describe Kavos...

Crazy Kavos! It's the comeback we needed. It's the hottest place I've ever been to!

Would you do Weekender again?

Everyone knows I would do it for 2024! I would do this until I've got a Zimmer frame and can no longer board a plane! For my mental health, it's something I love doing, because it puts me in a great mood, I learn so much about myself. Until you've done it you can't put into

words how good it is, it's unbelievable. I wish everyone could experience being a rep on the show.

Can you introduce yourself?
